A Kodiak man has been appointed by the governor to a seat on the State Council on Educational Opportunity for Military Children. Jimmy Ng has been heavily involved with local health care since retiring from the U.S. Coast Guard in 2002.

He works as the director of mission and spiritual care for Providence Kodiak Island Medical Center, and has been the director of the Kodiak Island Health Care Foundation.
